Why go to Camp?



Drop-off & Pick-up

Campers should arrive between **3:00-4:00PM** on the Sunday on which their camp begins. Official opening will be at 5:30PM. **Counselors will not be available earlier, and cabins will be locked until 3:00.**

On the Sunday on which camp finishes, parents are invited to the 10:00AM Divine Liturgy followed by an Awards Ceremony and closing camp remarks.
